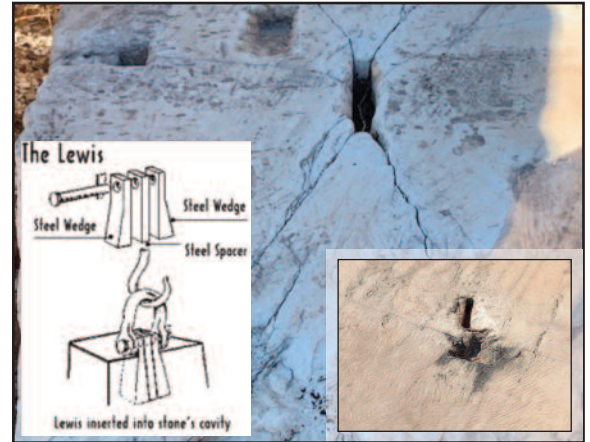


Information about the Lewis Jewel

"As many of you have heard during some of the presentations of the Lewis Jewel, I had occasion to visit Greece earlier this summer. Please note the marks on these stones that were used in the various buildings of the Acropolis in Ancient Greece. It is very easy to see that the Lewis device in Operative Masonry would be inserted in the hole to raise the blocks. After the device was removed it would have mortar placed in the hole. The same device adorns the Lewis Jewel that is presented to sons and grandsons and other direct descendants of a Mason."

Grand Constitution: SECTION 5. Lewis Recognition

A Master Mason who is a member in good standing of a New Hampshire Lodge, whose father, grandfather or great grandfather at the time of his Raising, or at the

time of their deaths, were members in good standing of a NH Lodge, or a Lodge of a Grand Lodge in amity with the Grand Lodge of NH, is entitled to wear an emblem or insignia, or receive a certificate, recognizing the Masonic family continuity. The emblem or insignia may have engraved thereon bars, or the certificate have written thereon, the names of the Master Mason, his progenitors and the dates each became a Master Mason. The award may be presented to him by his Lodge, and the Lodge may invite the Grand Master or the DDGM to be in attendance for the presentation. Certification of eligibility for the Lewis recognition shall be provided for and supplied by the Grand Lodge Office.

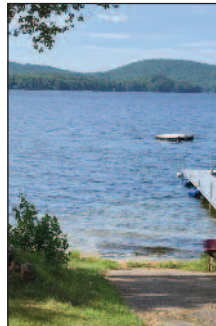
September 15th, 1 to 5 p.m., Wellington State Park
