Lodge in Darkness

Many clubs have amended their bylaws so their Lodge will not meet in certain months, such as in the summer due to vacations or the lodge being too warm; or during the winter when storms arise or to save on heating bills. Bro. Langis clarified that lodges can continue to conduct business such as holding special communications for initiating, passing or raising brethren, install officers, conduct Masonic Services, hold a Table Lodge, Veterans or Special Ladies Program, etc. Civic, social and fundraising events can also be held. What you cannot do, while your lodge is in darkness, is to conduct business that requires a stated communication such as receiving and acting on applications, or hold special elections for a vacant office without requesting a Dispensation well in advance for the Grand Master to consider and notify the lodge. The GLNH documents state: "Darkness" has no bearing on Lodge business ... it only means there are no Stated Communications!


